WHAT IS THE HILTI FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME?

The Hilti Fellowship offers excellent students the opportunity to be part of an international project team at Hilti while they attend lectures and seminars in the Master's Programme in Information Systems at the University of Liechtenstein.

WHO IS THE PROGRAMME AIMED AT?

The Hilti Fellowship is primarily aimed at Master's students from fields like information systems, business, and management; however, doctoral students and Bachelor's students who will complete their studies in the near future and plan to pursue a Master's degree in the following semester can also apply.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAMME WORK?

Participants work on real projects at Hilti three days a week and attend the Master's Programme in Information Systems on the other two days. The Hilti Fellowship is a paid internship; the salary covers the cost of living in Liechtenstein/Switzerland.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Because of visa regulations, the programme is open to EU/EEA and Swiss citizens.
